

7th boys, girls, 8th girls win first in 19-AA Junior High track meet

The Frankston seventh grade boys and girls and the eighth grade girls won first place in the District 19-AA Junior High Track Meet on March 29 and 30 at Kerens High School, according to a report from FHS Coach Lisa Hokit.

The eighth grade boys won second place in the meet.

The LaPoynor seventh grade girls won second place. The eighth grade boys won fifth place and the seventh grade boys and eighth grade girls finished in sixth place.

For the Frankston seventh grade boys in the 100-meter dash, Mason Boggs finished third with a time of 13.76 and Braylon Donnell was fourth with a time of 13.92. In the 200-meter dash, A.J. Donnell was first with 27.14 and Bradlee Gould was fourth with 28.28. Tristan McCoy finished sixth with 29.80. In the 400-meter dash, Hudson Smith was first with 1:03.96 and Joseph Allen was sixth with 1:13.95.

In the 800-meter run, Smith was first with a time of 2:39.29 and Davis Holliday was third with 2:45.84. In the 1600-meter run, Christian Serrato was third with 6:36.34 and Keaton Campbell was sixth with 8:03.23. In the 2400-meter run, Serrato was second with 10:16.53 and Gunnar Vinzandt was third with 12:32.34.

In the 110-meter hurdles, Campbell was second with a time of 21.31 and Stevie Fry was third with a time of 21.67. In the 300-meter hurdles, Fry was second with a time of 55.98, Holliday was third with a time of 56.45 and Campbell was sixth with a time of 1:03.25.

The 4x100 relay team of Boggs, A.J. Donnell, Braylon Donnell and Gould finished first with a time of 53.24. The 4x200 Relay team of Boggs, Braylon Donnell, Fry and McCoy finished first with a time of 2:00.58. The 4x400 relay team of Allen, A.J. Donnell, Gould and Smith was first with a time of 4:45.00.

In the Long Jump, A.J. Donnell was first with a leap of 16-8½ and Holliday was second with a jump of 14-1. In the Shot Put Holliday was second with a heave of 32-4 and Aiden Allen was third with a throw of 32-1. In the Discus, Aiden Allen was first with a throw of 77-7½. Jack Marshall was third with a throw of 71-8½ and Levi White was fourth with a throw of 69-5½.

In the Triple Jump, Gould was second with a jump of 32-2 ¾ and McCoy was fourth with a distance of 28-3½. In the High Jump Joseph Allen was third with 4-8, Holliday fourth with 4-6 and A.J. Donnell sixth with 4-4. In the Pole Vault, Carson Bizzell was first, clearing the bar at 7-6. Gould was second with 7-0 and Clay Foster was fourth with 6-6.

For LaPoynor, Gage Nuckolls was third in the 400-meter dash with a time of 1:10.15. Parker Beasley was fifth in the 800-meter run with 3:03.73 and fourth in the 1600-meter run with a time of 6:52.40. Mateo Estrada was fifth with 7:09.96. Nuckolls was fourth in the Long Jump with a leap of 13-0 and third in the Triple Jump with a jump of 29-0 1/4.

For the Frankston seventh grade girls, Ashley Fridinger was first in the 100-meter dash with a time of 14.14 and Bailey Jimenez was third with 14.65. In the 200-meter dash Kylie Morton was first at 32.31 and Kinley. Howie was fourth with 33.90. In the 40-meter dash Bailey Ball was first with 1:15.82 and Jimenez was second with 1:22.34.

In the 800-meter run, Jenna Gould was second with 3:24.50 and Ella Dowling was third with 3:29.17. Gould was second in the 1600-meter run with 7:49.13; Evie Freeze was third with 7:52.94 and Lauren Shults was fourth with 8:10.85.

In the 110-meter hurdles, Alyssa Thurman was first with 21.75 and Shults was second with 22.50. In the 300-meter hurdles, Thurman was second with 1:04.75 and Shults was fourth with 1:11.90.

The 4x100-meter relay team of Fridinger, Jimenez, Howie and Morton was first with 1:00.00. The 4x200-meter relay team of Angelina Gonzales, Freeze, Hailey Pizano and Morgan Redic was first with 2:29.30. The 4x400 relay team of Fridinger, Ball, Howie and Rachel Fletcher was first with 5:21.00.

In the Long Jump, Jimenez was second with a distance of 12-5½; Fridinger was third with 12-2 and Thurman was fourth with 10-11. Sydney Nelson was first in the Discus with a heave of 61-8 and Charleigh Hyde was fourth with 52-10½. In the Triple Jump, Howie was first with a distance of 22-10½; Gould was second with 22-3½ and Morton was third with 20-3½.

For LaPoynor, Savana Reynolds was second in the 100-meter dash with 14.24 and second in the 200-meter dash with 33.63. Emily Debusk was fourth in the 400-meter dash with 1:32.32. Emily White was first in the 1600-meter run with 7:11.43.

White was first in the 300-meter hurdles with 1:04.69 and Adriana Felder was third with 1:07.80.

Reynolds was first in the Long Jump with 12-8½. Hagen Mankin was first in the Shot Put with 28-2.

For the Frankston eighth grade boys, Reese Hicks was fourth in the 200-meter dash with 26.00 and Tyler Rogers was second in the 400-meter dash with 57.25. In the 1600-meter run Peyton Hoffman was fourth with 6:41.46. In the 2400-meter run Hoffman was first with 10:00.00 and Landon Reynolds was third.

In the 110-meter hurdles, Donie Burks was second with 21.12 and Jaden Singletary was third with 21.32. Burks was second in the 300-meter hurdles,

The 4x100-meter relay team of Hicks, Coleman Merritt, Rogers and Timothy Ryals was second with 49:15:00. The 4x200-meter relay team of Burks, Hicks, Merritt and Ryals finished second with 1:46.72. The 4x400-meter relay team of Merritt, Derrick Owens, Rogers and Ryals was third with 4:19.19.

Rogers was first in the Long Jump with a distance of 18-0. Burks was fourth with 16-1. Hicks was second in the Triple Jump with 32-3 and Ryals was third with 32-0½. Rogers was second in the High Jump with 5-4. Merritt was second in the Pole Vault with 8-0 and Reynolds was fourth with 6-6.

For the eighth grade girls, Wila Davis finished first in the 100-meter dash with a time of 13.91. Nyla Muhammad was third with 14.23. Aryonna Hatton finished fourth in the 200-meter dash with 30.93. Muhammad was first in the 400-meter dash with 1:11.27 and Chavez was third with 1:16.17.

Aubrianna Preston finished fourth in the 800-meter run with 3:22.68. Haley Bragg finished third in the 2400-meter run with 14:48.50 and Caitlyn Cox was fourth with 15:24.46.

In the 110-meter hurdles, Kysie Nabors finished second with 18.68 and first in the 300-meter hurdles with 54.79.

The 4x100-meter relay team of Aryonna Hatton, Desirae Hatton, Kaysiah Burnett and Wila Davis finished first with 57.29. The 4x200-meter relay team of the two Hattons, Burnett and Davis finished first with 2:07.08. The 4x400-meter relay team of Carly Morgan, Burnett, Nabors and Muhammad finished second with 5:02.00.

In the Long Jump, Burnett finished second with a distance of 12-5. In the Shot Put, Serenity Foster finished first with a heave of 28-7. Zoey Walker finished second in the Discus with a throw of 57-10½ and Addi Loebig was third with a toss of 57-8½. Nabors finished first in the Triple Jump with a distance of 29-6 and Morgan was first in the High Jump, clearing the bar at 4-4.

For LaPoynor, in the 100-meter dash, Bre Howard finished fourth with a time of 14.55 and was third in the 200-meter dash with 30.84. Adrianna Estrada was fourth in the 1600-meter run with a time of 7:47.67.

Howard finished fourth in the Long Jump with a distance of 11-8½.
